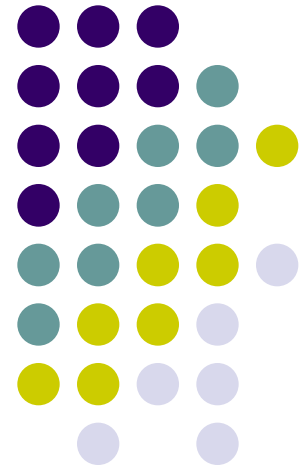

Guided Style searching allows you to simultaneously search for different terms in varying article citation fields. Begin by entering a search term in the first **Find** field, and then select which field(s) to search from the drop-down list, such as **Subject Terms**.

You can print, email, save, cite or export a single result from the Detailed Record when you click on a title link. To print, email, save, cite or export multiple results, add them to the folder, then click the appropriate icon inside the folder. Folder contents can be saved by clicking on the **Sign In** link, and then setting up a personalized (My EBSCOhost) folder account at no charge.
